

Presumpscot Regional Land Trust engages with communities to conserve, steward and provide access to local lands and clean water for current and future generations to enjoy. The Land Trust primarily serves Gorham, Gray, Standish, Westbrook and Windham - holding 1,840 acres of conserved lands with 15 free public access preserves that include trails and water access. The Land Trust is the water stewards of the Presumpscot River watershed and coordinates the Sebago to the Sea Trail, a 28-mile trail from Standish to Portland.
